Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons awarded to each age group (Walk-Trot/Jog, Junior, Senior) in each division, for the following classes:

ENGLISH DIVISION: 1, 3, 6, 9 or 11, 14

WESTERN DIVISION: 1, 4, 5, 14

CIRCLE THE CLASS NUMBERS TO MAKE SELECTIONS.

CLASS:

- OPN - Open Fitting and Showing*** - Walk-trot/jog, Junior, Senior.
- OPN - Lead-line - For the beginning young rider. To be led by an adult.
- ENG - Equitation*** - Walk-trot, Junior, Senior. Rider to be judged. May be asked to perform on an individual basis.
- WES - Horsemanship*** - Walk-jog, Junior, Senior. Rider to be judged. May be asked to perform on an individual basis.
- WES - Pleasure*** - Walk-jog, Junior, Senior.
- ENG - Pleasure*** - Walk-Trot, Junior, Senior.
- ENG - Open English Pleasure – Horses to be judged on manners, performance and suitability of horse to rider. The gaits will be walk, trot and canter. May be asked to back. To be ridden with a loose rein on command. Open to Junior and Senior riders. **Does not count towards Championship.** Pay-out class: 1st Place \$25, 2nd Place \$20, 3rd Place \$15.
- ENG - Warm-up Crossrails – Not judged. Five horses at a time for 5 minutes.
- ENG - Equitation Crossrails*** - Walk-trot, Junior, Senior. **MAY NOT ENTER BOTH 9 AND 11.**
- ENG - Warm-up Fences – Not judged. Fences 2'
- ENG - Equitation Over Fences*** - Junior, Senior, Equitation over Fences (21 inches). **MAY NOT ENTER BOTH 9 AND 11.**
- ENG - Hunter Equitation Over Fences (not to exceed 24 inches)
- ENG - Hunter Hack - Walk, trot, extended trot, canter, hand gallop. (Rail work and two fences not to exceed 24 inches).
- OPN - Trail*** - Walk-trot/jog, Junior, Senior - pattern to be posted
- OPN - Open Trail - Pattern to be posted. Open to Junior, and Senior Riders. **Does not count towards Championship.** Pay-out class: 1st Place \$25, 2nd Place \$20, 3rd Place \$15.
- OPN - Command - to be judged at a walk, jog, and lope
- OPN - Dollar Bill Race
- OPN - Egg & Spoon
- OPN - Musical Cones
- GYM - Gymkhana Cloverleaf - Junior, Senior - timed event, pattern to be posted
- GYM - Gymkhana Pole Bending - Junior, Senior - Timed event, pattern to be posted
- GYM - Gymkhana Keyhole - Junior, Senior - Timed event, pattern to be posted
- GYM - Gymkhana Flag Race - Junior, Senior - Timed event, pattern to be posted
- GYM - Open Jack-pot Barrel Racing - Cash Award 80% Payout

Additional Gymkhana classes may be added, time permitting.

*Count towards championships for age division.

Must comply with Rules & Regulations issued by The State of Connecticut, 2019.

RULES OF THE SHOW

1. No dogs allowed.
2. Decisions of the judge and/or superintendent are final. **DISORDERLY CONDUCT ON THE PART OF HORSE, RIDER, OR ANYONE WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE SHOW!**
3. Horses must have a current **RABIES VACCINATION**, which must have been administered no less than thirty days prior to the date of this event. A current (within one year) **NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST** is required. See Connecticut Fair and Show Regulations. **RABIES and COGGINS must be verified by an Official before a horse is admitted to the ring.**
4. **NO HORSES** will be ridden in ANY AREA other than the designated warm-up area and show ring. **ABSOLUTELY NO PEOPLE OTHER THAN THOSE ON HORSEBACK WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE WARM UP AREA!**
5. No stallions are allowed on the grounds, except for carriage classes.
6. Red ribbons must be on the tails of kickers.
7. Any class having fewer than four entries may be cancelled at the discretion of the show committee.
8. Entry Fee: **FREE** for all **pre-registrations**. Post-entry fee of \$25 per rider.
9. **Pre-registrations must be received by August 28, 2020, 11:59 p.m.** All information must be complete to qualify as a pre-registration. **PREFERRED METHOD TO PRE-REGISTER IS ONLINE AT WWW.TERRYVILLEFAIRHORSESHOW.COM.** Pre-registrations also accepted by email to kattmalley@gmail.com, or U.S. Mail to **KATHRYN MALLEY**, 174 Keegan Road, Plymouth, CT 06782. 10. Two persons per horse will be admitted free to the fairgrounds.
11. **A RIDER MAY NOT COMBINE THE POINTS OF MORE THAN ONE HORSE FOR ANY ONE CHAMPIONSHIP. (Separate numbers will be assigned for each horse).**
12. One Age Division per exhibitor only (Age Divisions as of January 1, current year).
13. Trail Courses will be posted at both secretary booth and at ring gate.
14. Proper attire, **BOOTS AND HATS**, must be worn (hardhats for English riders, with chin harness for jumping class!).
15. Crops or unrowelled spurs option to rider. Martingales not allowed in any flat classes.
16. Curb chains option to rider.
17. **ALL ENTRY FORMS MUST** be signed by parent or legal guardian (if minor).
18. **THE TERRYVILLE FAIR, THE HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE AND ALL HORSE SHOW OFFICIALS WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENTS OR ILLNESS THAT MAY OCCUR TO ANY ANIMALS, PERSONS OR PROPERTY, SHALL HOLD THEM HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THEM AGAINST ANY LEGAL PROCEEDINGS OR LIABILITIES FROM ANY SUCH ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS, OR LOSS OF PROPERTY.**

The Terryville Country Fair reserves the right to assess all pullers a fee of \$2.50 per animal per day to offset the cost of animal drug testing.

CT and OUT-OF-STATE Animals: All cattle, sheep and horses shall have a rabies vaccination given by a veterinarian at least 30 days prior to their first show date with a vaccination certificate signed by the veterinarian that gave the vaccination indicating the name of the vaccine and serial number. ALL SPECIES: Animals shall originate from herds or flocks that meet the testing and health requirements of the State of Connecticut and must be accompanied by health certificate and test charts.
